Rules for authors:

Conditions for the publication of the article:

- To ensure the integrity of scientific research, authors need to adhere to international standards of scientific publications.
- The degree of uniqueness of the article is checked for anti-plagiarism (in accordance with the decision of the editorial board).
- Articles that do not meet the requirements are not accepted for publication and are returned to the authors.

The language of publication is Kazakh, Russian, English.

The deadline for accepting the article is March 20, 2024.

The scientific article is formalized using APA Style.

The structure of the scientific article:

- IRSTI (Interstate Rubricator of Scientific and Technical Information) <https://grnti.ru/> ;
- The title of the article (capital letters, bold, in three languages: Kazakh, Russian, English);

- Full name of the author (bold);
- Abstract (50-60 words, italics, font size – 12);
- Keywords (4-5 words);
- Main part;
- Conclusion;
- List of references.

The volume of the article (excluding the title, information about the authors, annotations, keywords, bibliographic list) is 3-5 pages.

Requirements for the article:

- Format - Microsoft Office Word (.docx, .doc);
- Font - Times New Roman (for Russian and English), KZ Times New Roman (for Kazakh);
- The font size of the main text is 14, the font color is black;
- Margins: left - 30 mm, right – 15 mm, top – 20 mm, bottom – 20 mm;
- Text alignment to the width of the page;
- The indentation of the paragraph is 1.0;
- The line spacing is 1.0;
- There should be no additional line spacing between paragraphs;
- The use of styles when typing is not allowed and columns are not set;
- The output of comments in the fields is not allowed;
- The selection of the main word (thought) from the text is in italics, bold.
