Obligatory components

ISE 5011SE 501. Information technology in education and historical research. 5 ECTS Elective components

FPNH 501/1 Ethno genesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: HPhS 5201 History and philosophy of science

Aim of the course: To study the ethnographic history of the Kazakh people and its characteristic features.

Short description of the course: In-depth study of the ethnic history of the tribes that inhabited the territory of Kazakhstan, from the Bronze Age to the present day, the rocess of formation of the Kazakh nation, ethnogenetical and tribal connection, the emergence of the Kazakh zhuzes, their genesis, structure, ethnic associations, etc.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Study the historical background of ethnogenesis of the Kazakh people.

Skills: Review of theoretical problems of ethnogenesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people.

Abilities: As a result of training undergraduates get acquainted with the terms associated with the theoretical problems and applied aspects of the subject and can use them in practice.

Post requisite: . HKIF 5302. History of the Kazakh intelligentsia formation

FPNH 501/2. Social history of the Kazakh society in the XVIII-XIX centuries. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: HPhS 5201 History and philosophy of science

Aim of the course: Comprehensive analysis of historical processes and events of the XIIII-XX centuries in the context of the modern methodological approach in historical science.

Short description of the course: Social status of the Kazakh khanate of the XIIII-beginning of the XIX century. Relations between Kazakhstan and Russia at the beginning of the XVIII century. Accession of Kazakhstan to Russia. Kazakh society of the XVIII-first half of the XIX century. Political processes in Kazakhstan. Elimination of the Khan's power of the Junior and Middle Zhuz Struggle against the colonial system. Culture of Kazakhstan in the XVIII century. Introduction of the administrative and political system of Russia to Kazakhstan. Policy of khans of Central Asia in the South of Kazakhstan. National liberation movements of the first half of the XIX century. Introduction of a new system of administrative and political management in Kazakhstan in the 60-90 years of the XIX century. Kazakhstan's economy in the second half of the XIX century.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Studies historical data and historiographical information on the new history of Kazakhstan. *Skills:* Studying the history of Kazakhstan from the perspective of today, he can evaluate and draw conclusions from the point of view of national interests.

Abilities: Learns to make an analytical review of the history of Kazakhstan. Forms critical thinking skills. *Post requisite:* HKIF 5302. History of the Kazakh intelligentsia formation

FPNH 502/1. Formation of the Kazakh Khanate: the main directions and development. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: HPhS 5201 History and philosophy of science

Aim of the course: To study the formation of the Kazakh Khanate and the socio-economic and ethno-political developments in Kazakhstan in HIY-XY century.

Short description of the course: The aim of the course is to study the history of the Kazakh statehood, including the analysis of historical sources for the history of the Kazakh Khanate, their value, the content and meaning. The contribution of local historians in the study of the history of the Kazakh Khanate.

Expected results:

Knowledge: The analysis of sources relating to the history of the Kazakh Khanate, the definition of the value and importance of these sources;

Skills: An in-depth study of the history and structure of the Kazakh Khanate; *Abilities:* Research work with historical sources and their critical analysis *Post requisite:* MPHSS 5303. Methodological problems of historiography and source studies

FPNH 502/2. Evolution of the Kazakh statehood. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: EGEHKP 5205 Ethno genesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people.

Aim of the course: To study the evolution of Kazakh statehood from a modern point of view, linking with the world, evraziysoy history of nomadic civilization;

Short description of the course: The aim of the course is the study of the evolutionary history of the Kazakh people, the restoration uterennyh information about the identity of the people, the relationship with the past history of the modern heritage. Consideration of the Kazakh statehood from modern positions, and its relationship with the processes of world history, the history of the Eurasian space, civilization of nomads, the Turkic world and the peoples of Central Asia. *Expected results:*

Knowledge: In studying the subject "Evolution of Kazakh statehood" will form a national consciousness and unity;

Skills: Review the evolution of Kazakh statehood from a modern point of view;

Abilities: Research work with historical sources and their critical analysis

Post requisite: HKIF 5302. History of the Kazakh intelligentsia formation

FPNH503/1. Steppe civilization in the world historical process. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: EGEHKP 5205 Ethno genesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people

Aim of the course: analysis and interpretation of the main directions of socio-political, socio-economic and cultural development of the steppe civilization in the world historical space. Understand the differences between the formative and civilizational theories of the steppe civilization in everyday research.

Short description of the course: being in the Eurasian space, Kazakhstan since ancient times has been a connecting link between the civilizations of Eastern, Western Europe and Asia, the Turkic world in the steppe civilization, the interaction of historical and cultural ties with Chinese, Iranian, Slavic and European cultures.

Expected results:

Knowledge: objective analysis and interpretation of the main directions of socio-political, socio-economic and cultural development of the steppe civilization in the world historical space.

Skills: organization of independent study by students of new technologies for the analysis of sources of research and design work.

Abilities: reading, listening, speaking, writing skills and the formation of subject analysis skills by coordinating various approaches.

Post requisite: BMPT 6301 Basics of modern political trends

FPNH503/2. Totalitarianism: history and modern world. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: EGEHKP 5205 Ethno genesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people

Aim of the course: Causes and periods of totalitarian redundant system in the world, istoricheskkie preconditions and ways to implement them by the example of Germany and the USSR, modern forms of totalitarianism.

Short description of the course: The training course will examine the prerequisites of becoming masters of totalitarianism in the Soviet Union during Stalin's rule, China's Mao Tse-tung, in North Korea, Kim Il Sung, fascism in Italy and Germany, and analyze forms of government: 1) despotism, authoritarianism; 2) the Nazi regime; 3) the ideological direction of the control of a totalitarian regime. The consequences of his totalitarian rezhimai sovresennye views. *Expected results:*

Knowledge: Effects of the totalitarian regime and their victims

Skills: Differences of the totalitarian regime, a comparative analysis of totalitarianism in various parts of the world, its features and the eradication of

Abilities: research work with historical sources on totalitarianism and its critical *Post requisite:* BMPT 6301. Basics of modern political trends.

Elective components

HKTMP 502/1. Kazakhstan as part of the Soviet Empire: socio-political relations. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: SHKS 5205 The social history of the Kazakh society of the XVIII-XIX centuries

Aim of the course: To analyze the Soviet period in the history of Kazakhstan, to identify the position of the center in relation to Kazakhstan, the political and social situation of the Kazakh people as part of the empire. *Short description of the course:* History of Soviet Kazakhstan. The October Revolution and the political life of Kazakhstan. History of Kazakhstan during the Civil War. The role of the national intelligentsia in the formation of the national statehood Alash movement. Formation of Soviet totalitarian Kazakhstan: essence, measures and consequences. New economic policy in Kazakhstan. Issues of "transforming" Soviet Kazakhstan.

Expected results:

Knowledge:

- knows the problems of land policy in Soviet Kazakhstan, the political aspects of collectivization and industrialization;

Skills:

- get acquainted with the position of the Soviet government in relation to Kazakhstan, on the basis of this make a comparative analysis of the types of political power of the twentieth century; *Abilities:*

- conduct research on the history of Kazakhstan in the Soviet period, be able to express their opinions and draw conclusions.

Post requisite: DMIPS 6301 Development of modern ideological and political science.

Post requisite: TMDIPN 6301. The modern development of ideological and political nakui.

HKTMP 502/1. History of the Kazakh intelligentsia formation. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: EGEHKP 5205 Ethno genesis and ethnic history of the Kazakh people.

Aim of the course: To study the history of the national elite that took place in the history of the Kazakh people and analyze historical events in a new historical context.

Short description of the course: Formation and first steps of the national intelligentsia in the late XIX and early twentieth centuries. The Emergence of national demographic ideas among the Kazakh intelligentsia in the early twentieth century. Tasks of the Kazakh national intelligentsia in society: mass explanation of the essence of the ongoing political processes, conducting educational work, involving the population in the creation of a new state, etc. the Role of the national intelligentsia in education, cultural life and the formation of national consciousness of the Kazakh people. The role of the national intelligentsia, led by a. Bukeikhanov in the history of the Alash movement and its place in the history of the Fatherland. Historical destinies of the national political elite.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Development of scientific concepts to develop knowledge about the history of the Kazakh intelligentsia.

Skills: Mastering the skillful application of new technological methods in training

Abilities: Skills in data analysis, critical analysis and research.

Post requisite: MTDH 5303. Modern trends of domestic historiography

HKTMP 503/1. Methodological problems of historiography and source studies. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: FKKMDD 5206. Formation of the Kazakh Khanate: the main directions and development

Aim of the course: To consider the development of different periods of the historical science of world history and Kazakhstan, to determine their development methods, to determine the solution with different views.

Short description of the course: The aim of the course is to study the history of the development of historical science in Kazakhstan, the quality of historical research and their social role in sociopolitical and cultural-educational processes

Expected results:

Knowledge: Get information about modern history and historiography of foreign countries.

Skills: Methods of historical research and distribution, the concept of the main historical apparatus. *Abilities:* The formation of skills in their own areas of the problem

Post requisite: IAMHS 6302. Interdisciplinary approaches in modern historical science.

HKTMP 503/2. Modern trends of domestic historiography. 5 ECTS

Prerequisite: EKS 5206. Evolution of the Kazakh statehood.

Aim of the course: the study of theoretical problems of source study, the use of specific applied problems in the analysis of modern trends of Russian historiography as a source.

Short description of the course: Identification of modern stages of domestic historiography; show the level of development of ancient and medieval historical knowledge; Disclosure of the content of the main directions of Russian historical thought in schools of the XVIII-XIX centuries in the study of the history of Kazakhstan; to reveal the features of the development of historical science in the period of the Soviet totalitarian system

Expected results:

Knowledge: Masters, like future historians-researchers, should be able to use methodological, theoretical and specific research objects;

Skills: the ability to analyze the subject as a source in the history of Russian historiography

Abilities: The formation of skills in their own areas of the problem

Post requisite: BMPT 6301. Basics of modern political trends.

HKTMP 504/1. Organization and planning of research work. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: FKKMDD 5206. Formation of the Kazakh Khanate: the main directions and development

Aim of the course: Training highly qualified scientific specialists who are able to properly organize and conduct research work. Creative approach in the selection, search, writing and design of scientific research *Short description of the course:* Globalization, scientific and technological progress, informatization require the continuous development of specialists' qualifications, and increase their level of knowledge. Therefore, one of the main tasks of today is the preparation of competent specialists, and as a result, training in research technologies in writing a master's thesis. This course helps undergraduates to draw the right and high-quality conclusions from creative work, as well as create certain scientific concepts.

Expected results:

Knowledge: development of scientific and methodological knowledge and adaptation to the requirements of the international labor market, creative potential.

Skills: organization of independent study by students of new technologies for the analysis of sources of research and design work.

Abilities: reading, listening, speaking, writing skills and the formation of subject analysis skills by coordinating various approaches.

Post requisite: IAMHS 6302. Interdisciplinary approaches in modern historical science.

HKTMP 504/2. Problems of conceptualization in science. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: FKKMDD 5206. Formation of the Kazakh Khanate: the main directions and development

Aim of the course: Providing definitions of science and various definitions of science as a sociocultural phenomenon. Demonstrate the subject of science and systems of exact sciences. Functions of science: cultural expression, social representation of productive power. A review of the evolution of each side in the study of science.

Short description of the course: concepts individual concepts in the learning process; concepts of age characteristics of people; national concepts are being studied. The problems of conceptualization in science will be examined in detail, and the work of L.L. Nelubina, M. Kushtaeva, D.S. Likhachev and V.V. Kolesov.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Description of an important component of knowledge, which leads to a high level of scientific research and the preparation of master's theses.

Skills: The history of science and the exact sciences studies the dynamics of the development of science and its impact on society.

Abilities: The methodology of science allows a graduate student to understand modern problems and methodological foundations of science, is acquainted with the theory of methods, concepts, methods, methods, methods of scientific activity.

HKTMP 601/1. Basics of modern political trends.. 5 ECTS

Their main streams are liberalism, conservatism, nationalism, Marxism, fascism, pacifism and much more.

Expected results:

Knowledge: to teach topical issues of political movements from a modern point of view, to know the features of the structure of modern political movements, the system of political parties and political parties.

Skills: be able to correctly navigate the history of current political movements, analyze, select and study the facts regarding any regional changes and social life, with an excellent knowledge of historical facts.

HKTMP 601/2. The modern development of ideological and political nakui.. 5 ECTS

As a result of such interaction of objects, the skills of solving urgent problems of scientific knowledge and research are formed.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Typology and classification of historical research, types of scientific activity, forms and types of their implementation, final result and recommendations

Skills: Plan, organize and conduct research

Abilities: The formation of skills in their own areas of the problem.

Post requisite: ATTHMM 6303. Applied technology in teaching history: methodology and methodology

HKTMP 602/2. Information technology for historians. 6 ECTS

Prerequisite: ITEHT 5301. Information technology in education and historical research

Aim of the course: The subject is trained in order to improve the pedagogical skills of undergraduates.

Short description of the course: Features of teaching historical disciplines. The use of active and innovative methods in the teaching of history. Types of history lessons, and the use of visual aids. *Expected results:*

Knowledge: Knowledge development using interactive methods in the classroom;

Skills: Using interactive teaching methods;

Abilities: The formation of practical and theoretical knowledge based on modern techniques; *Post requisite:* ATTHMM 6303. Applied technology in teaching history: methodology and methodology

CIS 603/1. Applied technology in teaching history: methodology and methodology 6 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: ITEHT 5301. Information technology in education and historical research *Aim of the course:* the Proposed course is intended to familiarize future teachers of historians with various methodological approaches in historical science, with the principles of research, with mathematical processes and computerization processes, with the principles and methods of historical education and the application in practice of new technologies of historical creativity. *Short description of the course:* the stability of the process of learning history, the purpose of improving the effectiveness of its content is considered. The subject is based on modern concepts and methodological work of historians.

Expected results:

Post requisite: MHS 6304. Methodology of historical science.

CIS 603/2. Innovations in historical education. 6 ECTS

Prerequisite: ITEHT 5301. Information technology in education and historical research

Aim of the course: Search for information, collection and processing, skills for displaying research results. *Short description of the course:* Theory of scientific cognition, theory of science, methodology of scientific creativity, organization of research, the concept of theory and methodology, organization of a scientific experiment, the content of the unit research, evaluation and assessment of scientific problems. *Expected results:*

Knowledge: Training students in modern methods of scientific researches, getting information about the latest achievements, new results.

Skills: Skills of using modern methods of scientific research in works by mastering them.

Abilities: the master's Student uses the knowledge gained in the course of studying the discipline to acquire skills for evaluating research methods, developing and resolving conflict situations.

Post requisite: MHS 6304. Methodology of historical science.

CIS 604/1. Methodology of historical science. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: ITEHT 5301. Information technology in education and historical research *Aim of the course*: To study the theory of historical knowledge, kinds of scientific methods, skills and techniques of historical research.

Short description of the course: The course is designed for future teachers of arms historians with different thodological approaches, principles of research of mathematization processes and computerization in historical science, education applying the principles of historical knowledge, methods and new technologies historical creativity in practice. The base are modern concepts and methodological works of scientists historians.

Expected results:

Knowledge: Practical application of methods of historical research and modern technology; *Skills:* Mastering the specific historical materials through methodological analysis;

Abilities: Formation of skills of objective detection of regularities in the historical process. *Post requisite:* no

CIS 604/2. Modern development of historical science. 5 ECTS

<u>Prerequisite</u>: ITEHT 5301. Information technology in education and historical research

Aim of the course: In the course "Development of historical science at the present stage", the problems of the development of domestic historical science at the present stage, starting with the history of independence of Kazakhstan, are examined. The crisis of Soviet socialism and the collapse of the USSR, the formation of independent Kazakhstan. Domestic and foreign policy activities of Kazakhstan

Short description of the course: The course considers the purpose of the development of historical science at the present stage, the content and legitimacy of the process with the aim of increasing and effectiveness in teaching history.

Expected results:
