Optional component 1

Course: Modelling and forecasting in sociological research

Intensity of the Course: **5** academic credits

Module Code: FMSR - 2

Module Name: Fundamentals of Sociological research

Prerequisites: No

Purpose: Study of methodological and organizational approaches to the construction and functioning of a forecasting system, design and modeling of social phenomena and processes, in particular, in the field of sociology.

Short Description: The course is aimed at studying modeling and forecasting in scientific research, which began to be applied in ancient times and gradually captured new areas of scientific knowledge. The 20th century brought great success and recognition to the modeling method in almost all branches of modern science. The method of modeling and forecasting determines specific forms of using abstractions, analogies, hypotheses, other categories and methods of cognition.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 - Predicts social phenomena and processes to identify socially significant problems and develop solutions based on the use of scientific theories, concepts, approaches and social technologies

Learning Outcomes in Course (LOC):

- LOC 1 to familiarize undergraduates with the patterns and features of the formation and development of the forecasting mechanism, design and modeling of social phenomena and processes in Kazakhstani society;

Course: Focus groups as a method of applied sociological research

Intensity of the Course: 5 academic credits

Module Code: FMSR - 2

Module Name: Fundamentals of Sociological research

Prereauisites: no

Purpose: Obtaining a general understanding of the possibilities of the method of collecting social and marketing information using focus groups and acquiring knowledge and skills in organizing, conducting, analyzing the information collected.

Short Description: Acquisition of competencies, skills in organizing, conducting a focus group, analyzing the collected information. This is useful for those undergraduates who, in their future activities, will face the need to organize focus groups, conduct them independently, and also analyze the results obtained by this method.

Purpose: promoting the formation of undergraduates' ideas about the methodology and methods of psychological and pedagogical research, the formation of research competence and their willingness to apply the knowledge and skills acquired in organizing their own scientific research and organizing research work in their professional activities.

Short Description: The course is focused on the study of methods, technologies and practical recommendations in the study of problems of society. The main direction in the study of sociology is the institution of the family and the category of people in need of social assistance.

Short Description: The basic concepts and principles of experiment planning, correlation and regression methods for analyzing experimental data, drawing up a multivariate experiment plan, statistical processing and analysis of its results are presented.

The most acute issue is related to the institution of the family and the problem of youth employment.

Purpose: The main goal is to acquaint undergraduates with modern approaches, methods and techniques of applied sociological research, to teach innovative skills for collecting, processing and analyzing empirical information.

Short Description: The complication and acceleration of changes in modern society, in the context of modern globalization and the rapid development of the role of the world information network and other conditions, require the use of new methods of social survey technology. These technologies should take into account the rapid change in the social status of the modern generation, as well as the development of other mobile processes. The rapid development of modern computer technology also has a heuristic effect on sociological research.

Purpose: To form the key competencies, knowledge, abilities, skills necessary for future professional activities related to the regulation of the migration problem in the modern world among undergraduates.

Short Description: This course is an area of knowledge about migration problems, processes and systems, and is also an interdisciplinary research area.

Purpose: the formation of undergraduates' scientific ideas about social changes as a set of phenomena and processes of changing the states of social reality, occurring in its spatial and temporal certainty, fixed in the observed and measured differences, the measure of quantitative and qualitative properties and characteristics inherent in these states.

Short Description: One of the most general and broadest sociological concepts. Depending on the research paradigm, social change is understood as the transition of a social object from one state to another, a change in the socio-economic formation, a significant modification in the social organization of society, its institutions and social structure, a change in established social patterns of behavior, renewal and growth of the diversity of institutional forms and etc.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 - Uses methods of obtaining and working with information in the professional sphere taking into account modern technologies of the digital economy and information security

Learning Outcomes in Course (LOC):

Module Name: Professional assessment of social phenomena and ethical communication in sociology

Prerequisites: MTSS Modern technologies of social survey

Purpose: Formation of a system of knowledge among undergraduates about the theoretical and applied aspects of the analysis of everyday sociocultural practices, the foundations of sociological thinking, which makes it possible to form a vision of the structures and layers of everyday life, everyday life as a standardized and normalized section of empirical life.

Short Description: At the individual-personal, socio-psychological level, this dominant tendency turned out to be consolidated by a number of typical life-meaning orientations, ideas about fair and unjust,



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which are characteristic of classical history, classical social intelligence, focusing on such mechanisms as industrialism, rationalism, individualism, economism, democracy that set the main goal to meet the needs of survival, enrichment, enjoyment, ensuring the rights of the individual, the individual for free development.

Purpose: preparation of masters in the program "Social technologies of modern management", expands the knowledge about the directions of using social technologies for solving managerial problems, obtained in the course of mastering the disciplines.

Short Description: Formation of professional competence among undergraduates in the development and use of systems for processing and analyzing large data arrays. This goal correlates with the goal of the educational program, in particular, with technologies for the development of specialized software systems responsible for processing big data.

Module Name: Information society and communication

Prerequisites: TDTSC The development of the theory of social change

Purpose: to form the undergraduate's understanding of the features of speech and non-verbal communication of its varieties, knowledge of the features of the communicative environment (household, industrial, political, trade, public relations, etc.)., channels and types of communication (oral, print, audiovisual, virtual and etc.), audiences and communication principles; the ability to use the principles of communication theory in the analysis of communication activities and events (press conferences, exhibitions, seminars, company actions, etc.) and in planning their own activities.

Short Description: studying the structure of the communicative act; connection between communication theory and semiotics and linguistics, information theory and hermeneutics, philosophy, psychology; acquaintance with the basic theories of communication; description of the structure of the communicative act in various spheres of communication (intercultural, interpersonal, mass, organizational, etc.); introduction of basic concepts and principles of communication; creation of ideas about the personal aspects of the communicator.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 - Predicts social phenomena and processes to identify socially significant problems and develop solutions based on the use of scientific theories, concepts, approaches and social technologies

Learning Outcomes in Course (LOC):

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Short Description: The study of the discipline involves mastering basic knowledge and skills of working with office computer systems; knowledge of the basic provisions governing the organization's information processes, which is the subject of professional training and determines the specifics of the construction and functioning of information systems and technologies in the field of sociology.

Short Description: The course is aimed at developing the professional ethics of sociologists and mastering professional skills. Any professional interaction and communication must proceed in accordance with ethical norms and standards. The ability to build relationships with people, to find an approach to them and their disposition to oneself is the basis of the professional success of a young specialist.
