Course: Scientific research undergraduate Intensity of the Course: 5academic credits

Module Code: SME-2

Module Name: Scientific and musical educational

Prerequisites: Fundamentals of Scientific Research (bachelor's degree)

*Purpose:* Providing undergraduates with basic knowledge on the requirements, forms of musical and pedagogical research and research work on a master's thesis.

Short Description: The first module provides basic concepts of research work: qualification "Master" and its scientific status; general methodology of scientific creativity; general understanding of the master's thesis; methods of scientific knowledge; types of scientific literary products; ways to prepare for writing a dissertation

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 — Demonstrating knowledge of the content of philosophical, linguistic, psychological and pedagogical, historical and theoretical, performing disciplines aimed at professional in-depth training of a specialist in the system of music education.

Learning Outcomes in Course (LOC):

- LOC 1 Knowing and understanding the content of the discipline, as well as the theory and practice of organizing the research work of the master student.;
- LOC 2 -Provingthe understanding of the studied problems of the discipline, whenever possible applying and solving problems in practice, using information and communication technologies.

*Purpose:* To give scientific foundations to master students of special knowledge on the requirements, forms of musical and pedagogical research and research work on a master's thesis

Short Description: research culture of a music teacher, its features and essence, the content of research activities; research methodology of the musical and pedagogical process; individual and creative attitude of the applicant to research activities.

Research stages and results; methodological characteristics of musical and pedagogical research; types of research of musical and pedagogical activity. Methods of research work of a music teacher; methodological analysis of the problems of pedagogy of music education; scientific organization of mental work.

Organization and implementation of experimental work; acquaintance with musical and pedagogical experience; organization of research practical work of a music teacher.

*Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):* 

LOP 1 - Showing an understanding of the goals, objectives, direction and content of this educational program, the prospect of its implementation, the field of music education, as well as in the field of related Sciences, which guarantees professional competence and social mobility in the modern changing world.

*Short Description:* The concept of musical psychology. Musical ability. Musical reception. Psychological mechanisms of musical perception. Musical performance psychological aspect. Problems of music psychology in music education. Psychology of various activities in music lessons.

Short Description: The main laws of musical psychology and its relationship with other sciences. The personality and activities of a music teacher. Musical and creative abilities. Cognitive processes in the cognitive activity of a music teacher (will, attention, feelings, perception, memory, thinking, imagination). Individual psychological qualities of a music teacher. Communicative processes in musical activity.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

Short Description: In the course of mastering the topic of world music education, the master student learns:

- a) modern music education;
- *b) the content and features of music education in Western Europe;*
- b) directions and trends in the development of music education at the world level;
- c) ability to compare and differentiate the features and differences of musical education on foreign and Kazakh basis.

*Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):*

Short DescriptionThe subject of the foreign system of music education is the subject of a wide, broad, comprehensive knowledge.

The features of the stages of musical education are differentiated considering the ways of development of the musical art of the nations of Europe, in each state.

The current state of music education in educational institutions of preschool education and higher education is considered.

Module Name: scientific and pedagogical

Prerequisites: Digital Technologies in Music Education (bachelor's degree)

Purpose: optimization of traditional methods of teaching music using modern information technologies.

*ShortDescription*: Electronic music education programs are programs related to the informatization of the educational process, the improvement of software and methodological support and material base. One of the most promising areas in music education.

Electronic Music Education Programs:

- 1) a technology that describes the procedure for the development, operation and use of information processing tools of various types;
- information resource created on the basis of technologies for processing and presenting information of various types; computer software, the functioning of which is associated with the processing and provision of information of various types;
- 3) computer hardware, with the help of which it is possible to handle information of various types;
- 4) a special generalizing type of information that combines traditional static visual (text, graphics) and dynamic information of various types (speech, music, video clips, animation, etc.).

*Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):* 

LOP 1 – Development of effective teaching methods and techniques in the educational process, educational and methodological documentation aimed at developing students 'in-depth musical knowledge.

The use of modern computer technologies can significantly reduce the amount of information carriers. The peculiarity of modern digital media lies not only in their practicality, but also in their durability, which allows you to store the recorded information without losing its quality.

A subject that determines the relationship between the foundations, stages and pedagogical research of a scientific project. Analyzing the main directions of the scientific field and research of today, it allows to study scientific design. Preparation of publications in scientific and pedagogical journals of the world.

Prerequisites: Main musical instrument, choral conducting. Vocals (bachelor's degree)

*Purpose*: Issues of performance of works of a high level of complexity on the concert stage - the experience of communicative approaches aimed at the international presentation of Kazakhstani art, along with performing activities. Concert performing practice includes a high level, all-round specialization, activation, improvement of creative, performing education.

Short Description: The course "performing practice" under the guidance of the teaching staff is one of the prerequisites for becoming a concert performing artist during the period of master study, concretizing the performing directions received by the university.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 – Introduction of their own disciplines into the educational process, advanced pedagogical experience of famous Russian and foreign teachers-musicians of the past and present.
