3. RESOURCE SUPPLY OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

3.1.LIBRARY FUND

One of the important in dicators of the quality of training in the educational program is the provision of student swith educational, methodological, scientific literature, reference and periodicals.

The library Fund forthe EP cipher and name as of may 1, 2020 is 52453 copies, in cluding in the state language -39339 copies, 12989 copies in Russian and 152 copies in foreignl anguages.

The University library provides students and faculty with access to data bases: IPR books, Polpred, Alembook, Web of Science, Elsevier (Scopus).

Access to the Republican inter university electronic library (RIEL), which combines electronic educational and scientific resources of Universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan, is provided.

Students of the educational program have access to the following scientific journals: "Zhuldyz", "Zhalyn", "Akyz adam", "Alashshyl zhas", "Kazakh tili men adebieti", "Tiltanym".

Since 2010, the library provides an opportunity for students of Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University to get acquainted with the content of master's theses in traditional format (more than 150 titles), half of it have been converted into PDF format.

Students can also use the "Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University's Electronic library" service, which provides access to the electronic library from a computer anywhere in the world in 24/7 format (website address: lib.kazmkpu.kz). There are about 10,000 full-text sources, more than 1,000 licensed books, 6676 scanned books by the library staff, and about 300 books that belong to the rare collection.

3.2. TEACHERS STAFFING

3.3. MATERIAL AND TECHNICAL BASE

On the basis of the department there are auditoriums «History and typology of Kazakh literature» (2006), "Kazakh folklore" (2011), «Z. Akhmetov and the foundations of Kazakh literary criticism» (2002). Named classrooms are equipped and equipped with modern facilities, scientific publications and books on literature on folklore, helping students to fully engage in science.

On the basis of the department there are circles «Izdenis», «Nazkogyr», «Inzhu-marzhan». The main functions are to teach students creative thought, scientific research and impressive reading.

Students who come from other regions are provided with a hostel. All conditions have been created for the residents of the hostels, the employees of the hostels conduct various social, cultural, sports events and competitions. Each student house has an equipped gym. All student houses have an internet connection in every room.

Logging into the system is carried out by 80енными computers connected in the educational process, and 70 % computers used in the administration of educational activities. All educational buildings have a wireless Wi-Fi network.

On the territory of the university there is a medical center, a psychological center "Zhan shuagy".
