# **3. RESOURCE SUPPLY OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

#### 3.1. Library fund

One of the important indicators of the quality of training in the educational program is the provision of students with educational, methodological, scientific literature, reference and periodicals.

As of may 1, 2020, the library Fund for UO 7M02301 "Philology" consists of 1089,262 copies, 945,677 of them in the state language, and 5,959 publications in electronic media.

The University library provides students and faculty with access to databases: IPR books, Polpred, Alembook, Web of Science, Elsevier (Scopus).

Access to the Republican interuniversity electronic library (RIEL), which combines electronic educational and scientific resources of Universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan, is provided.

Students of the educational program have access to the following scientific journals: XLinguae. European Scientific Language Journal, International Journal of Environmental and Science Education, European Journal Of Natural History. International journal of environmental & science education, Life Science Journal, International journal of applied and fundamental research.

Since 2010, the library provides an opportunity for undergraduates of the Kazakh National Women's Pedagogical University to get acquainted with the content of master's theses in the traditional format (more than 150 titles), half of which are translated into PDF format.

Masters can also use the "Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University's Electronic library" service, which provides access to the electronic library from a computer anywhere in the world in 24/7 format (website address: lib.kazmkpu.kz). There are about 10,000 full-text sources, more than 1,000 licensed books, 6676 scanned books by the library staff, and about 300 books that belong to the rare collection.

#### 3.2. Staffing

The educational program is implemented by the Chairs Theories and methods of Kazakh linguistics and Kazakh literature. Quantitative and qualitative indicators of faculty serving the educational program (disciplines of basic and major cycles):

### 3.3. Material and technical base

The university has a modern social infrastructure. The total area of 23,458.8 square meters. and usable area 13215.6 sq.m. m. It has 3 educational buildings. Currently, the university has 5 interactive lecture halls, 37 specialized multimedia classrooms, educational laboratories and language laboratories. The property of KazNZhenPU is 23111.6 square meters. There are 6 dormitories, as well as the House of Scientists for the faculty. On the territory of the university there is a medical center, psychological center "Jean ShuaFy".

The university's scientific library covers an area of 42952 m. It is located in a separate building, where there are 5 transfer points, 1 subscription and 5 reading rooms.

As a base of practice, contracts were signed for the use of the base Of the Baitursynov Institute of linguistics, the base of the Auezov Institute of literature and art, and the base of the pedagogical College No. 1 in Almaty.
