Prerequisites: History of the Kazakhstan (school program)

Purpose: Based on the program articles of Elbasy N.A. Nazarbayev's "Course towards the Future: Modernization of Kazakhstan's Identity" and "Seven Facets of the Great Steppe" consider the history of the Great Steppe as a part of World history, show historical events and processes, the interaction of nomadic Turkic culture, focus on the development of historical consciousness to educate young people for civic consciousness and patriotism.

Short Description: The discipline is aimed at educating the national spirit, respect for history and national traditions in modern Kazakh ladies. The course covers the features of the cultural worldview and perception of the world by the Turks, the national code of the Kazakh people, the historical and social foundations of its culture and cultural values, as well as moral teachings in the Great Steppe and the social foundations of the national idea.
