1.3. RATIONALE FOR THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The increasing volume of innovations, new requirements for educational results, a different system for assessing learning outcomes, issues of integrating information and library activities require updating the content of the library specialist's activities, concentration of intellectual resources, the desire to independently search for the necessary information for the critical, creative development of new behavioral strategies in the ongoing professional activities. The training program for bachelors of social knowledge in the educational program 6B03201 - Library Science was developed taking into account the generalization of modern domestic and world experience in training in this area, the author's and collective scientific achievements and educational and methodological developments in the field of specialization, the requirements of employers and the demands of the labor market. An additional education program "Information Resources Manager" is provided. Within the framework of the program, the possibility of

obtaining an additional specialty as a manager is considered, which allows expanding the professional competencies of a library specialist.

The Kazakh National Women's Pedagogical University has material and pedagogical resources to meet the needs of students. In this regard, the educational program is developed with an emphasis on practice orientation and includes a large number of elective disciplines designed to provide practical skills in librarianship. The program is aimed at meeting the requirements of our time and contains disciplines that reveal innovative achievements in the field of librarianship and the experience of foreign countries.

Market need. In accordance with the influence of social transformations, the changing role and place of libraries in the information space, public libraries of the republic are improving the organization of services to meet the information needs of all categories of users, the methodology for acquiring and cataloging library collections, the system of public access to high-quality publishing products, and providing conditions for public access to socially significant information through the creation of information systems and other technologies, play a huge role in introducing readers to the historical and cultural heritage of the people. According to statistics, as of January 1, 2022, the country's population is 19 million 082 thousand 467 people, of which 5 million 44 thousand 497 (27.8%), or every 4th Kazakhstani, is a reader of one of 4056 public libraries of the Republic of Kazakhstan. At the end of 2021, there were 11,310 libraries of all systems and departments in the country. Of these: public libraries - 4,056 (35.9%), libraries of the system of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan - 7,152 (63.3%) and 102 libraries of other systems and departments (0.8%). Currently, there are 6 higher and 16 secondary specialized educational institutions in the republic, which provide training in the specialty "Library Science".
