1.3. THE RATIONALE BEHIND THE EDUCATION PROGRAM

Topically of educational program. The educational program is developed taking into account the generalization of modern domestic and international experience in this field, author's and collective scientific achievements and educational and methodological developments in the field of specialization, the requirements of employers and the demands of the labor market. One of the priorities of the bachelor of education program in the educational program "6B01101 – Pedagogy and psychology" is a double-degree education.

Market demand. According to the Ministry of education and science in Kazakhstan, the network of educational organizations amounted to 18,600, including 10,314 pre – school organizations (4,057 in the city and 6,257 in the village), 7,393 General education schools (including 2,055 urban and 5,338 rural schools (72%), 769 colleges and 124 universities.

There are 7 special schools for children with deviant behavior, 19 centers for the adaptation of minors and one support center for children in difficult situations. According to the Committee for the protection of children's rights of the MES, there are more than 11,788 dysfunctional families in the country, where more than 17 thousand children are raised.



Family support services operate at the centers for the adaptation of minors.they provide advice, legal, psychological, and pedagogical assistance to children and parents who find themselves in a difficult life situation.

In Kazakhstan, there are 31,405 children with special educational needs aged 1 to 6 years. There are 43 special pre-school organizations and 469 special groups in 201 mass pre-school organizations that provide psychological, medical and pedagogical correctional support to 109 teachers-psychologists.

School education implements the principle of equal rights to equal opportunities for all children, regardless of their health status. According to foreign research, children with disabilities are three times more susceptible to various forms of bullying. Therefore, for children with special educational needs, it is important to create a favorable psychological climate. In 2019, the network of psychological and pedagogical correction offices will expand from 152 units to 185, and psychological, medical and pedagogical consultations-from 58 units to 85.

As can be seen from official statistics, at the present stage, there is a high need for specialists in educational psychology.

1.4. DISTINCTIVE FEATURES OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

3. RESOURCE SUPPLY OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

3.1. LIBRARY FUND

One of the important indicators of the quality of training in the educational program is the provision of students with educational, methodological, scientific literature, reference and periodicals.

The library Fund for the EP 6B01101 – Pedagogy and psychology as of may 1, 2022 is 22761 copies, including in the state language – 4429 copies, 17754 copies in Russian and 578 copies in foreign languages.

The University library provides students and faculty with access to databases: IPR books, Polpred, Alembook, Web of Science, Elsevier (Scopus).

Access to the Republican interuniversity electronic library (RIEL), which combines electronic educational and scientific resources of Universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan, is provided.

Students of the educational program have access to the following scientific journals:

«Questions of psychology», «Psychology», «Psychological science and education» Bulletin of KazNZhPU, Bulletin of Al-Farabi KazNU (Psychology series), Scientific and methodological journal «Pedagogy and psychology», scientific journal Bulletin of KazNPU (Psychology series).

Since 2010, the library provides an opportunity for students of Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University to get acquainted with the content of master's theses in traditional format (more than 150 titles), half of it have been converted into PDF format.

Students can also use the "Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University's Electronic library" service, which provides access to the electronic library from a computer anywhere in the world in 24/7 format (website address: lib.kazmkpu.kz). There are about 10,000 full-text sources, more than 1,000 licensed books, 6676 scanned books by the library staff, and about 300 books that belong to the rare collection.

3.2. Teachers staffing

The educational program is implemented by the Department of Theoretical and Practical Psychology. Quantitative and qualitative indicators of faculty serving the educational program (disciplines of basic and major cycles):
