Short Description: The course is aimed at the formation of a legally competent, law-abiding person who knows his rights and obligations, intolerant of any manifestations of corruption. Students will be able to operate with the social, legal and ethical norms of Kazakhstani society.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 1 - Applies a variety of communication formats taking into account socio-cultural diversity, adheres to the principles of equality and accessibility in education, to create a prosperous and inclusive environment, has leadership qualities and is able to apply them to develop collective potential

Reveals the basic laws of the functioning of ecosystems of various levels of organization, the biosphere as a whole, the contradictions that arise in the relationship between man and nature, as well as the need for respect for nature and ecology.

Module Code: **TFSW-4**

Module Name: Theoretical foundations of social work

Prerequisites: Theory and history of social work

Purpose: "Social statistics" - to give students a comprehensive knowledge of the basic mathematical and static methods that are used in sociological research, to introduce the procedure of quantitative and qualitative measurement of the object of research.

Short Description: The course is studied in order to form the basic concepts, contents and structures of social security, its place and role in the national security system, the regulatory framework regulating the activities of social

security agencies, the nature and nature of risks and threats to the security of individuals and society in the social sphere of life. Studying the course, the student is able to calculate indicators and indicators of social security, conduct a scientific analysis of social, economic, environmental processes in society.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 4 – Applies the rules of ethics of behavior, morality, life and social values of professional activity, forms theoretical knowledge in the socio-pedagogical, psychological, diagnostic and advisory sphere.

Prerequisites: Social institutes and processes

Purpose: Conflicts in social work is one of the social and humanitarian disciplines that helps to form the public consciousness of students, that is, to understand the various problems of contradictions of social work in modern society.

Short Description: The course forms students' knowledge of the history of the emergence, object and subject of social contradictions in social work. Studying the course, the student learns the process, dynamics, models and methodology of ways to solve the social conflict between groups and classes. Learn to manage conflicts in social work.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 6 - Implements and participates in the development of socially innovative technologies in the field of social work with social groups and individual clients.

Purpose: To give students a comprehensive knowledge of the basic mathematical and static methods that are used in sociological research, to familiarize them with the procedure of quantitative and qualitative measurement of the object of research.

Short Description: The course is studied in order to form the basic knowledge and methods of collecting, processing and analyzing mass data characterizing the life of the community, using specific techniques characteristic of the study of the social sphere. During the course, the student will learn how to apply new methods of mathematical, statistical calculation and analysis.

Conducts a sociological analysis of the problems of society in the political, social, demographic, cultural and religious spheres at the macro, meso and micro levels of social change. The student can conduct scientific research, give conclusions and recommendations.

Short Description: The course is studied in order to form skills for analyzing the current state of the social protection system in the Republic of Kazakhstan. Capable of implementing activities for the provision of social services, social support, social support measures and state social assistance, as well as the prevention of circumstances causing the need for social services of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Purpose: The study of socio-psychological, cognitive processes, the phenomenology of personality development, human actions and relationships.

Short Description: The course forms students' skills of using psychological knowledge for professional and personal self-development, improving the activities of social protection institutions, shows the psychological specifics of social work with different social groups of clients.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 4 - Applies the rules of ethics of behavior, morality, life and social values of professional activity, forms theoretical knowledge in the socio-pedagogical, psychological, diagnostic and advisory sphere.

LOP 11 - Has knowledge of emotional intelligence, resistance to the behavior of citizens in a social environment. Organizes and regulates the support of advisory activities to solve social problems in various groups of the population, inclined to gain experience.

LOP 12 - Has the skills of quantitative and qualitative analysis in solving social problems and phenomena, a high level of civic responsibility and the skills of a leader of social initiatives.

Short Description: The course is studied in order to form students' knowledge and skills of psychological counseling based on the features of social work, depending on the individual needs of citizens. Students develop skills in correction, rehabilitation, counseling in practice, determining individual needs by various groups and individual citizens. A student can make an individual support plan depending on the living conditions of citizens.

Purpose: The discipline social work with various groups of the population teaches students the rules and norms on social protection provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan On social protection of the population in society, the organization of social protection, state management and control in the field of public safety and social protection of the population, guarantees of public safety and the rights of social protection of the population in the process of social activity.

Short Description: The course is studied in order to form knowledge about the rules and norms of social protection provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan On Social protection of the population, the organization of social protection and safety of the population. Forms the ability to generalize, analyze, apply, set goals and find ways to achieve it in the context of professional activity.

Learning Outcomes in EP (LOP):

LOP 4 - Applies the rules of ethics of behavior, morality, life and social values of professional activity, forms theoretical knowledge in the socio-pedagogical, psychological, diagnostic and advisory sphere.
