Intensity of the Course:5 academic credits Module Code: MSP 705/1

Module Name: Methodology and scientific priorities of philology

Prerequisites: ORW 702 Methods of scientific research

*Purpose:* Understanding the basic principles of quantitative and qualitative research. Be able to distinguish between quantitative and qualitative research projects. Developing skills in data collection methods for both types of research. The use of appropriate data analysis methods to obtain quantitative and qualitative data. Critical evaluation of scientific research and recognition of its strengths and limitations. Demonstration of effective transmission of research results.

*Short Description:* A student in this discipline fully masters the types of quantitative and qualitative research methods. Data collection methods; ethics of data collection; in-depth interview, semi-official interview, expert interview, focus group discussions, observations, experiments; use and distinction of quantitative and qualitative research methods in scientific research; case study in qualitative research; quantitative research methods; working with the Jamovi, SPSS application; T-test, correlation, topics of descriptive analysis, regression, linear regression, factor analysis, ANOVA, pareto analysis, etc. are included.

*Short Description:* The discipline studies the peculiarities of Kazakh grammar in a functional aspect in a structural and systemic unity. The main sections of functional communicative grammar, methods of linguistic analysis used for scientific research, linguistic analysis of facts and an algorithm of interpretation in the functional aspect are considered.
